**Ryan Cochran-Siegle
2012 World Junior DH Champion**

March 2nd - MMSC alum Ryan Cochran-Siegle, 19 won the World Junior DH in Roccaraso, Italy. This is an outstanding result and an impressive accomplishment. The World Junior Championships is an annual International event for the worlds top junior competitors. Many competitors are current World Cup athletes. Ryan's win is only the 5th DH Gold Medal for the U.S. in history. Other winners include Julia Mancuso, Chris Beckmann, Adam Cole and Michael Makar.

Another member of the famous Skiing Cochrans, Ryan Cochran-Siegle's mother is 1972 Olympic slalom gold medalist Barbara Ann Cochran, which also means he's cousins with U.S. Ski Teamer Jimmy Cochran. But he didn't make the Team by family attrition; he crushed the final half of the 2010 season with the overall Eastern Cup title and the U.S. Junior Championship for Super G propelling him to the U.S. Development Team as a high schooler.
