

MMSEF Scholarships & Awards

Paul Biedermann Scholarship

Awarded to honor this past president of MMSC, this scholarship is awarded to:

- a U14 or U16 women
- who has a financial need and
- who demonstrates focus and determination of purpose, both athletically and academically.

This scholarship will be based on the annual income from this endowment (approximately \$500/year).

Charles F. Black Scholarship

Awarded to honor the past president of MMSC and Founder of MMSEF, this scholarship is awarded to the athlete who best represents these characteristics:

- must be a resident of Vermont
- be a fulltime student in Vermont
- be enrolled in the MMSC junior race program
- is unable to pay for the full cost of their education and enrollment in the race program

The annual income from this endowment (\$750 approximately) will be used to perpetuate Charlie's efforts to assist junior ski racers in their pursuit of excellence.

William J. Kreizel Award

Presented to the athlete who best represents these qualities:

- Financial need
- Enthusiasm for ski racing

The athlete named must meet the following requirements:

- Athlete is a U16, U19, U21, or Post Graduate
- Must be competing in upper level of their age group
- Athlete must be a MMSC athlete in the upcoming ski season

Depending on the interest gained in the Kreizel Fund, this award will provide a maximum of \$1,500 toward travel and equipment expenses for the upcoming ski season. This scholarship is granted to one male or one female alpine ski racer who will be nominated by the MMSC coaching staff.

Doug Parker Achievement Award

Awarded to the athlete who best represents these characteristics:

- Marked improvement
- Strong work ethic
- Dedication to the sport
- Perseverance

This scholarship will be awarded to one male and one female and has a value of \$500 for each recipient.

Jeff Stone Award

Awarded to one athlete who best represents these characteristics:

- Achievement as a U16 alpine ski racer
- Demonstrates future potential as a ski racer
- Exhibits good sportsmanship
- Demonstrates enthusiasm for the sport of ski racing

Award value of \$1000 and is funded by Mr. and Mrs. Barry Stone

George Tormey Award

Presented to the athlete who best exhibits these characteristics:

- Love of the sport
- Spirit
- Future potential as a ski racer

This merit award will send one young promising MMSC alpine ski racer to a MMSC-sponsored summer ski camp. The value depends on the interest gained in the George Tormey Fund (approximately \$500 annually).

Currently Name-Only Awards:

Alumnae Award

Awarded to the athlete who best represents these characteristics:

- Self-motivated
- Well rounded
- Exemplifies the spirit and philosophy of the MMSC program

This award was established by Emily Copeland, a graduate of Dartmouth and the MMSC race program and, later, a MMSC coach. The award was designed to be perpetuated by Alumnae contributions. Original scholarship: \$500 In recent years the award is in only.

Craig Burt Award

Presented to one male and one female alpine athlete at the U21 or U19 level who have distinguished themselves as both outstanding students and athletes.

This award has had a value of \$1,000 to be divided equally to both recipients. However the scholarship founders no longer support it financially, making this a name-only award.

Betsy Snite Riley Memorial Award

Awarded to the **female** athlete who best represents these characteristics:

- Good sportsmanship
- Top results
- “Lady-like” demeanor
