Cochran-Siegle, Bedareva Take Back-To-Back NorAm Super G Wins In Nakiska

NorAm Cup speed races continued today (Dec. 7) in Nakiska, AB with another set of men's and women's super G races.

As he did in yesterday's race, American Ryan Cochran-Siegle was again on top of the men's podium, beating second place finisher, Canadian Dustin Cook by 0.16 seconds.

The Americans had a respectable presence in the top ten as Wiley Maple snagged the third spot on the podium, 0.39 seconds off of Cochran-Siegle's time. Just 0.01 seconds behind Maple was Chris Frank in fourth and Bryce Bennett in fifth.

Also in the top ten was yesterday's winner (tied with Cochran-Siegle Tuesday), American Erik Fisher in seventh place.

There was also a repeat winner on the women's side as Russian Maria Bedareva took a 0.17-second edge on Canada's Madison Irwin. Finishing in third was Russian Anastasia Kendrina 0.45 seconds off the leader.

Other American women in the top ten were Paula Moltzan in eighth place and Lauren Samuels in ninth place. Both were top-ten finishers yesterday as well.

The NorAm speed skiing will continue tomorrow (Dec. 8) in Nakiska with men's and women's downhills.
